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THINGS TO REMEMBER WHEN SPOTTING SEALS IN THE WILD

It is really important that you do not disturb seals in the wild for various reasons. Disturbance can cause major stress, interrupts their rest time, wastes important energy and sadly sometimes can even result in injury or death.



If you have been spotted, move further away!



Keep your dog on the lead



Keep your distance. It is best practise to observe seals from at least 100m away



Never approach, touch or feed wildlife



Use binoculars or zoom lenses to observe seals in the wild



Do not put pups back in the sea, all seals need to rest and often haul out on the beach
